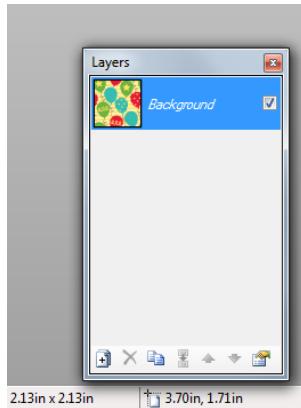


Adding Text to your project

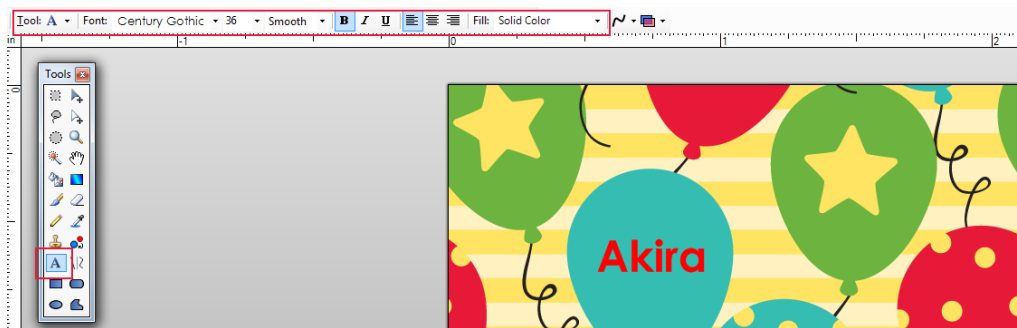
Whether you're adding text to a design or a project the basic keystrokes apply to everything you do within the Fabric Studio. If you are having problems understanding **layers**, I suggest you view the video on "**Layers for Dummies Part 1**" on our Resource Page of our website.

Adding Text to your Fabric Design

- **Select your design/make sure it is on your workspace**
- You will notice that your design is the background layer in your **Layer Box**



- **Click on your Text Tool (A) on Tool BarT**



- **Select Font/Select Font Size/Select other Text options**
- **Select Font Color from Color Box**
- **Add a layer in the Layer Box**
- **Place cursor on design and start to type text.** Notice that once you stop typing the cursor is still pulsing, at this point you still able to change Font, Size, Color extra. Until you click on **enter** you are able to make changes to your text. If you make an error hit **Ctrl+Z** which will bring the cursor pulsing back so you can continue editing text.
- Make sure your text is on Layer 2 in the Layer Box, if not you will not be able to edit your text successfully. If you have made an error, keeping on hitting **Ctrl+Z** until your text disappears and add **layer** in the **Layer Box** and start again.
- Remember every time you add additional **text** in a new area; make sure you add a **new layer** in your **Layer Box** before you begin.
- To edit/move text see **Edit/Move Text PDF**
