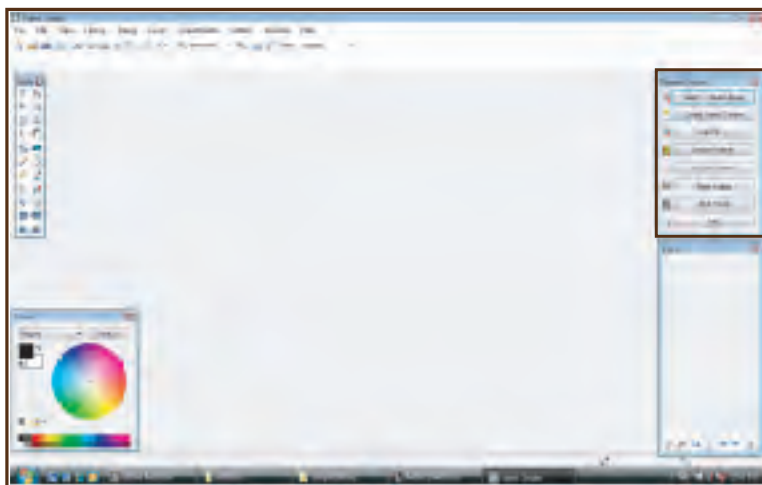


Get Creative

Combine multiple images and text into a file

To combine multiple images and text into one file, you will open all of your images, then copy them one at a time and paste them into a blank canvas.


Step 1: Click on the Select/Create image button on the Pattern Design palette. The Select/Create Image window will open.

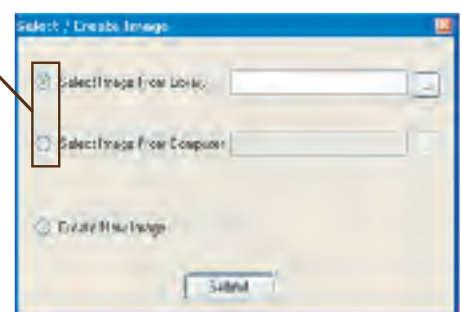
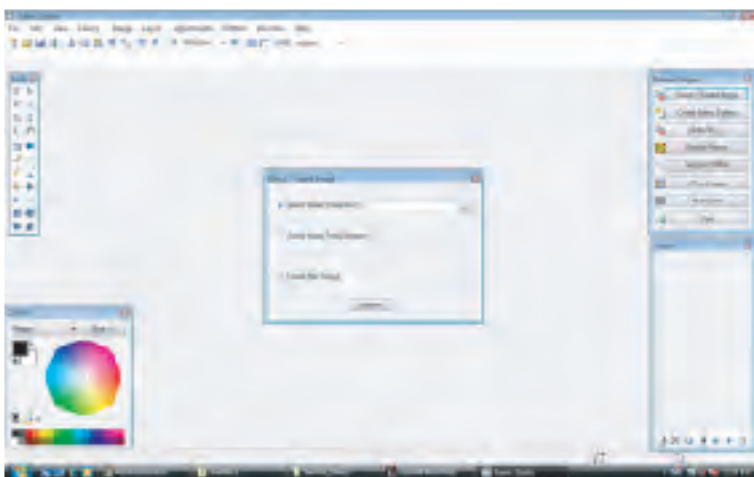


This is the Pattern Design Palette.



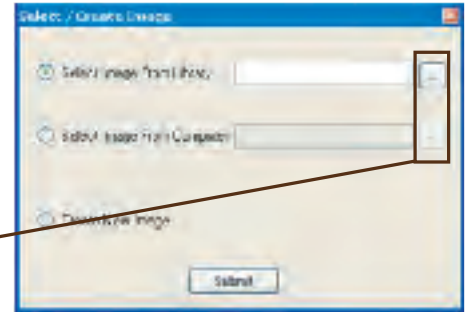
You will click here in FabricStudio

Step 2: Click the () button to the left of "Select Image From Library" (Fabric Studios Images), or "Image From Computer" (where, if you have any, are where your images are).

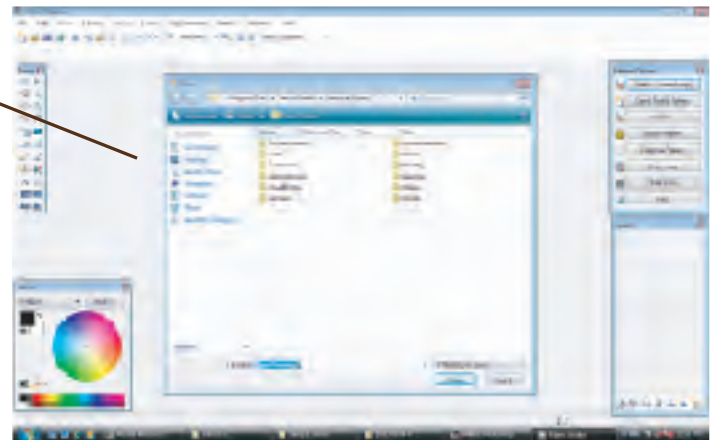
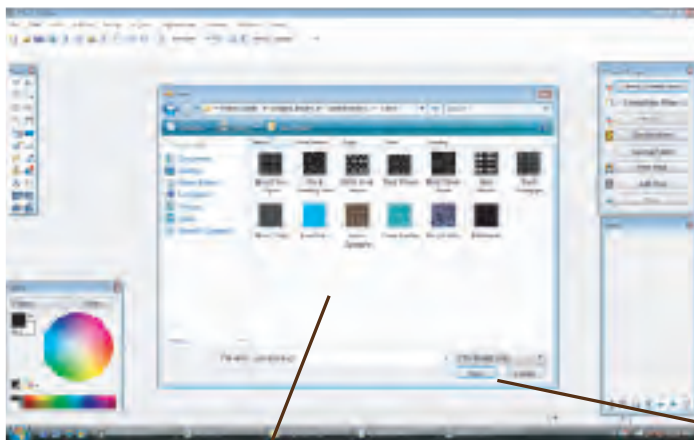


Step 3: Click the browse button () to the right of "Select Image Library"

(This will open a window where you will search for the image that you want to use from the FabricStudio library)



Step 4: Select the folder that you want and click open.



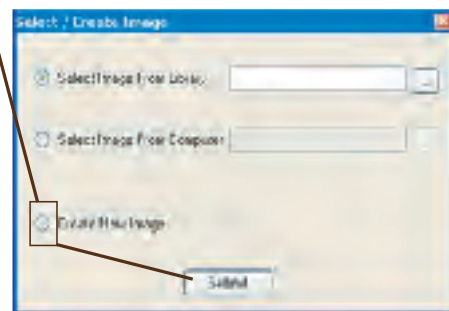
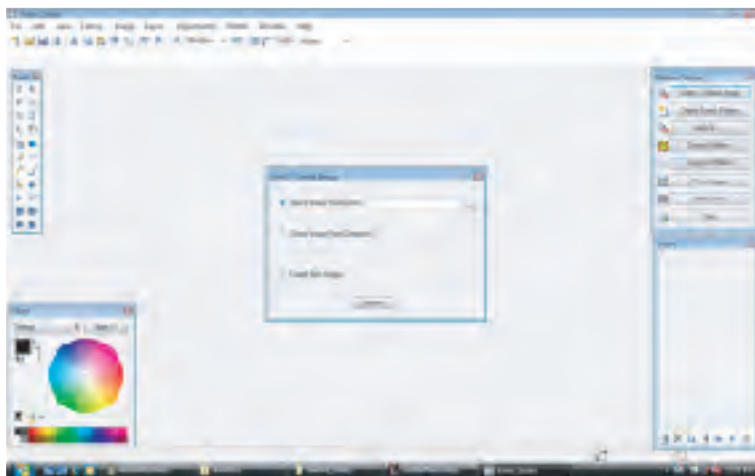
Step 5: Select the image that you want to use and click open.

Step 6: You will need to repeat Step 1-5 for all of the images that you want to use in your combined file.

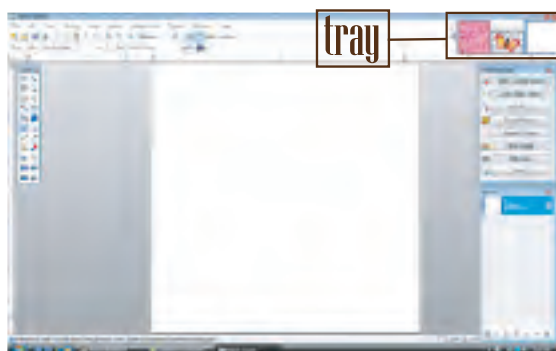
Now that you have all of the images opened, you will need to create a blank canvas by "Creating A New Image"




Step 7: Click the  button to the left of "Create New Image" and then Submit.

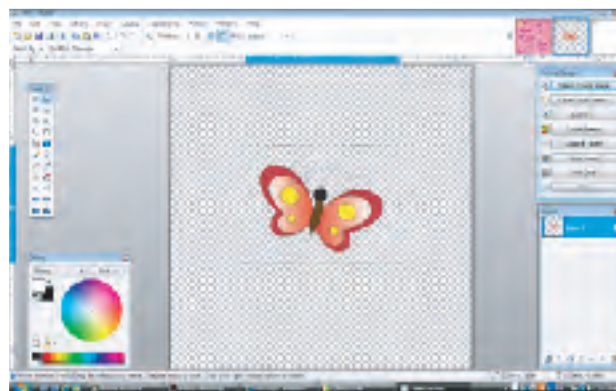


Step 8: Click on an image in the tray on the top right to select it. The tray shows the files that you have opened. (The first 2 here are images that we opened and the 3rd one is the new blank canvas where we will combine images.



Step 9: Using the "Rectangle Select" tool , click and drag around the image that you want to copy.

Step 10: On the top bar, click on Edit then Copy.



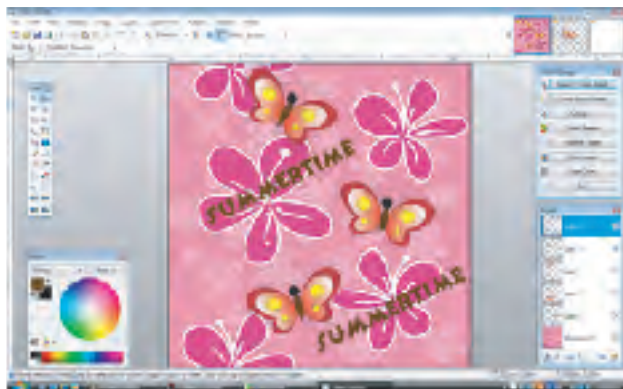
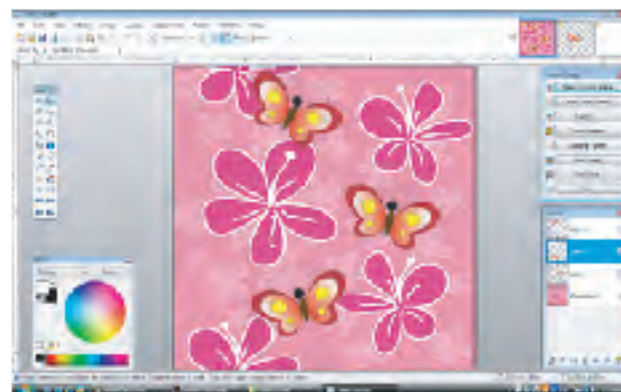
Step 11: In the tray, click the blank canvas to select it. You will need to create a new layer by clicking on the Add Layer button ()

Step 12: On the top bar, click on Edit then Paste.

If you want to move your image: click on the rectangle select tool, click and drag your mouse around the image. Click on the move selected pixels button and click and hold down the left button on your mouse and move the image to where you want it to be.

If you want to rotate your image: click on the rectangle select tool, click and drag your mouse around the image. Click on the move selected pixels button and click the image with the left button on your mouse. Click and hold down the right button and drag your mouse which will rotate your image.

Step 13: Repeat Steps 9-12 with all the images.



Text: If you want to add text, click on the text button () on the tool bar, click on your canvas and type.

You can move the text by doing Step 13. You can rotate your image by doing the "rotate" step above.

Save: On the top row click on File then Save.

Make sure that you know where you are saving the file to. Type in the name that you want to save your file as.

Select .png under Save As Type.

You will be asked if it is ok to flatten your image. Click on Flatten.
