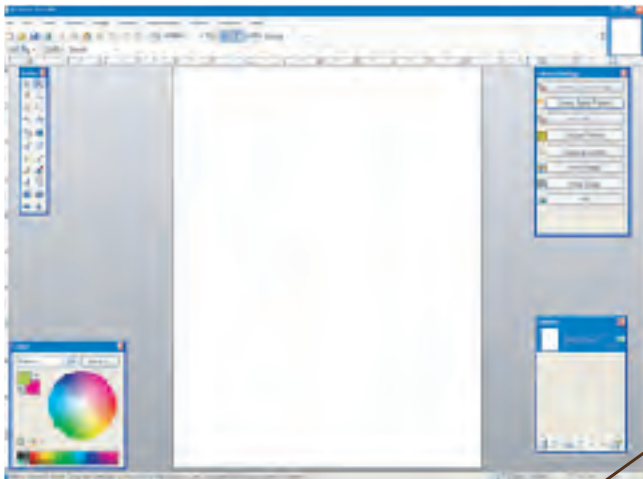

Make a Fun and Unique Memory Quilt

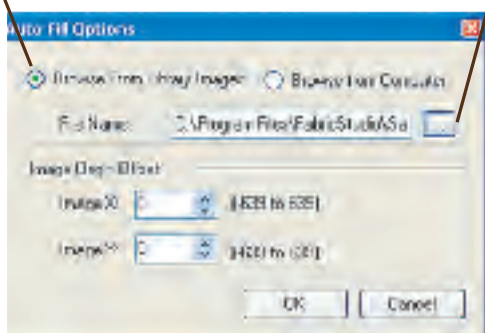
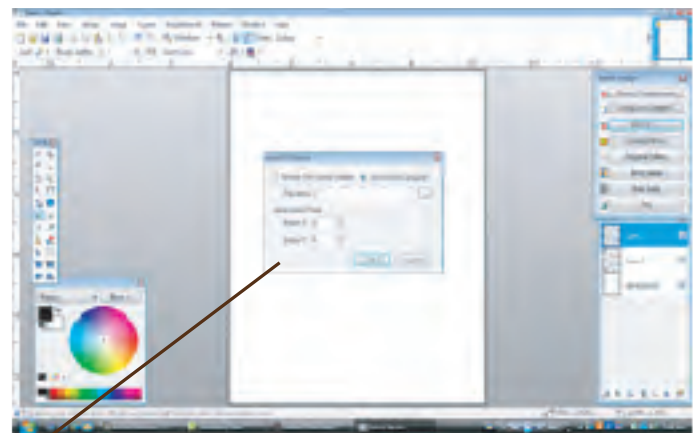
Making the Background:

Step 1: Click on the "Create Fabric Pattern" button on the Pattern Design palette. A standard 8 1/2 x 11 workspace will appear.

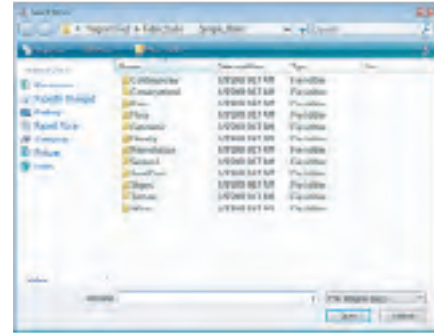


← You will click here in FabricStudio

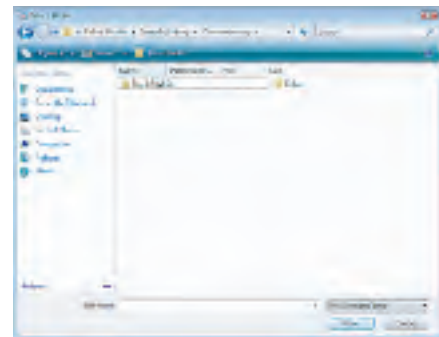
Step 2: Click on the "Auto Fill" button which will open the "Auto Fill Options" window. Select "Browse From Library Images" click on the browse button () which will bring you the list of Library Images.



Step 1:
Double click on the file folder
you want to open.



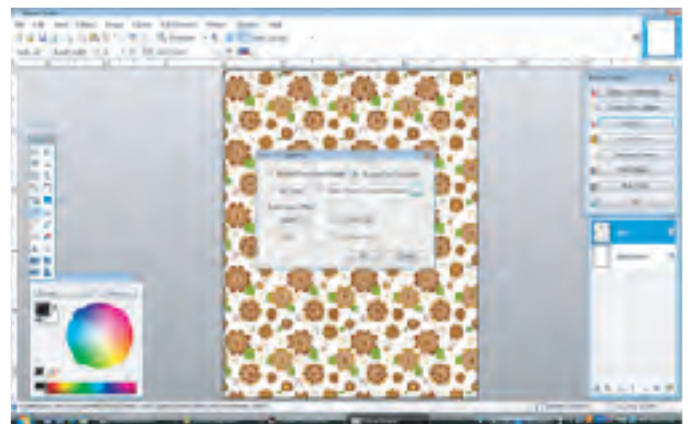
Step 2:
Double click on either Color or
Black & White.



Step 3:
Find the image that you want
and double click to open.

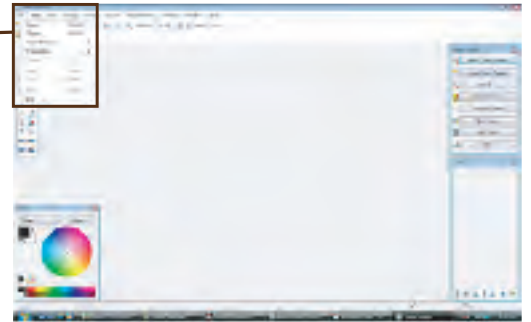


Step 4:
The Auto Fill Box will come
up again. Click OK. Your
Image will start to Auto
Fill the Pattern Sheet.

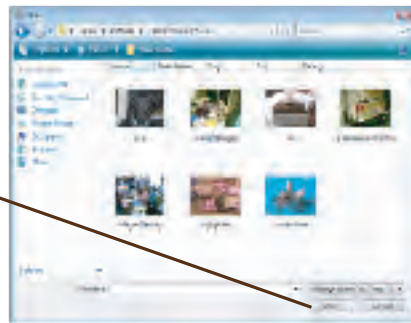


Adding Your Photos:

Step 1: On the top row click File and Open.



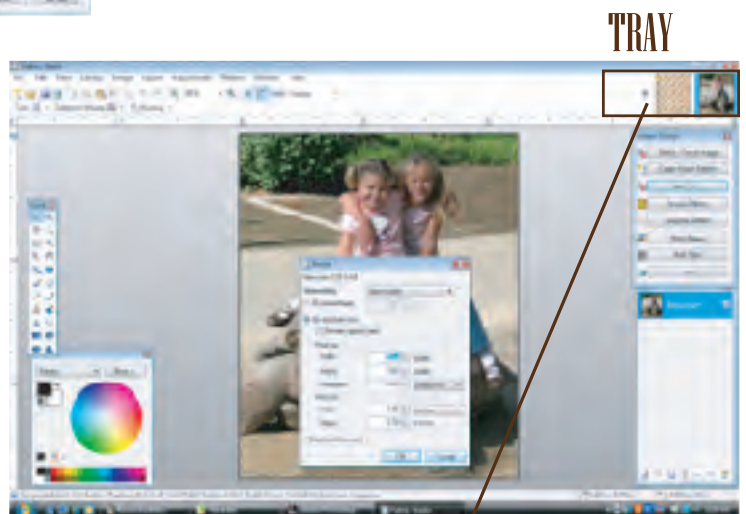
Locate your photo and click Open.



Resizing Your Photo:

Step 1: On the top bar click Image then Resize, which will open a window

Step 2: Type the desired size of your file and click OK.



TRAY


Repeat all of the steps for opening and resizing all of the photos that you want to use. Keep your files open. You will see each one in the tray at the top of your workspace. You can click on the thumbnail of the file that you want to work on.

Combining Your Photos and Background:

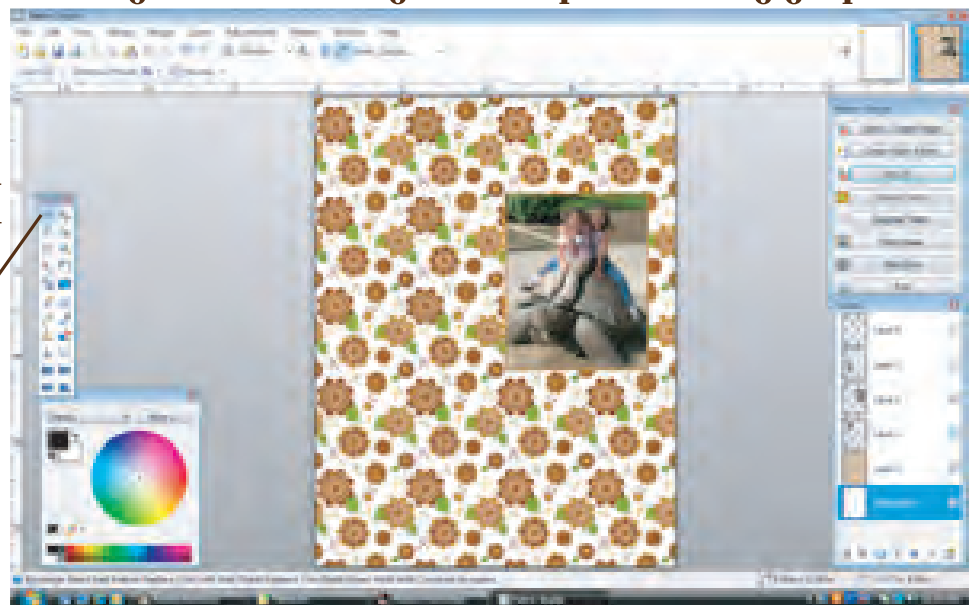
Step 1: In the tray on top click onto a photo that you will add to your background.

Step 2: On the top, click "Edit" then "Select All", then click "Edit" again and "Copy".

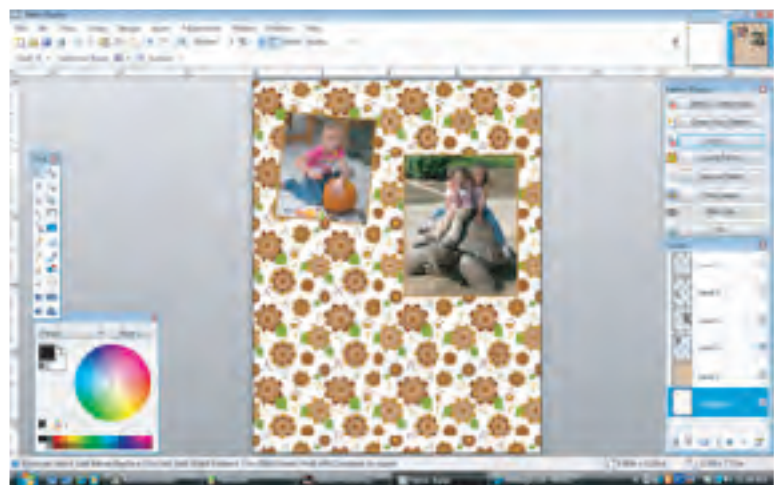
Step 3: In the tray on top click onto your background image.

Step 4: Click the "Add New Layer" button () on the Layers Window. (By adding a new layer when you add images, it allows you to make changes to only the image that you want to and not the entire background. Also, if you add a photo or any graphic onto the background without adding a new layer first it deletes anything that is behind your new photo.)

Step 5: On the top, click "Edit" then "Paste"

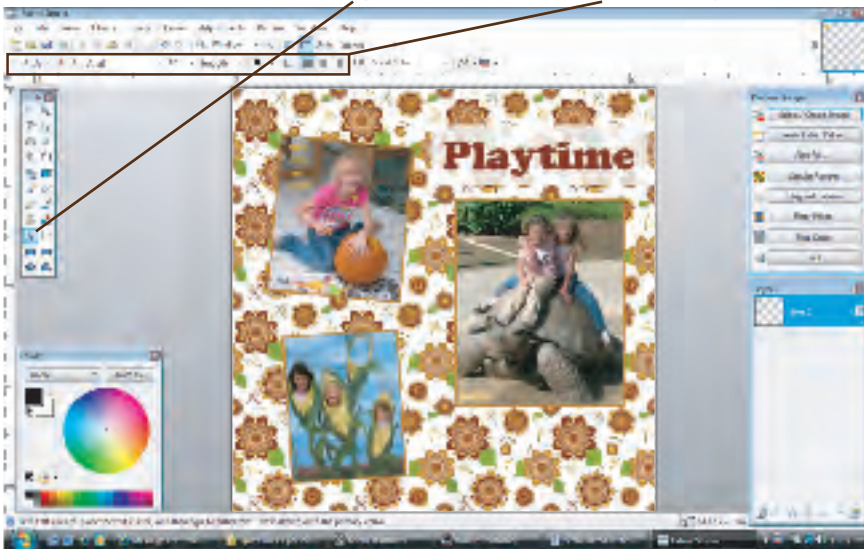


If you want to rotate your image: Click on the rectangle select tool, click and drag your mouse around the image. Click on the move selected pixels button and click the image with the left button on your mouse. Click and hold down the right button and drag your mouse which will rotate your image.




Adding Text:

Step 4: Select the Type Tool () pick your Font/Size/Color and Fill and type.



You can rotate, resize, move and copy/paste your text. If you are adding text or names with photos or graphics, then do that first and then add your text. To learn how to rotate, resize, move and copy/paste continue reading.

To Rotate Your Text/Image:

Step 1: Click onto the rectangle select tool (). Click and drag your mouse over the text to select it.

Step 2: Click onto the move selected pixel tool ()

Step 3: You can rotate the image by right clicking on the corner of the image

To change the size of your text/image:

Step 1: Click onto the rectangle select tool (). Click and drag your mouse over the text to select it

Step 2: Left click on one of the corner boxes while holding down the shift key and resize your image.
