


RESIZING TEMPLATES or IMAGES

For A4 SIZED FABRIC SHEETS (8.3" Wide)


The software assumes that you are using standard Letter-sized sheets, which are 8.5" inches wide. Resizing your Templates or Images to use A4 sheets (which are 8.3" wide) is simple to do with the following steps...

Note: I recommend that you resize the Template/Image prior to starting your project. But if you are printing Templates or Images that are not wider than 8.3" wide (such as Quilt Labels), then you do not need to resize them.


Slide 1 - Select the Template/Image, and at the top (circled in red) it will show the dimensions which, in this example, is 8.51" by 8.51".



Slide 2 - To resize, click on "Save Template" on the right side of the menu. This will once again show the current "Image Size" of the Template/Image.



Slide 3 - Change your "Image Size" to your desired size (in this example, the Template was changed to a width of 8.3" to fit size A4 sheets). Then rename the file in the "File Name" field, and select where you want to save this resized Template/Image in your computer. Then click "Save".



Slide 4 - Once you click "Save", you will notice that the size of the Template/Image on the screen has not yet changed. You will need to reopen your new-sized Template/Image by first clicking on "Start New Project". Then select either Template or Image, click on the "Browse" button, locate your newly-resized Template/Image, and select "Open". The newly-resized Template/Image will now appear on your screen, and you can start your project.
